Final Transcript

TO COMPLETE YOUR COLLEGE APPLICATION.....

A final transcript must be sent in June to the college of your choice. It will include your 8th semester grades and proof of graduation. You MUST fill out a "FINAL TRANSCRIPT" request form indicating which college you want to receive a copy of your final transcript. **Your admission process will not be complete until the college has a copy of your "final" transcript. "Final Transcript" request forms are available in the Counselors' Office or below. Turn in to Ms. Wall in the Counselors' Office.**

GRADUATION DRESS REQUIREMENTS

This is a formal occasion, students should be appropriately dressed

- Appropriate clothing for males is dress pants, white or light colored dress shirt and tie, and dress shoes.
- Appropriate clothing for females is a dress or dress slacks and low-heeled dress shoes. **Heels of ladies shoes must be at least the size of a quarter to walk on the field.**
- Graduates may not wear corsages or carry purses, bags, or cameras.
